Today, world record dives are being attempted and made on a regular basis at Skydive City.

The combination of an excellent location (just minutes off I-75, 30 minutes from Tampa airport), engaging staff and sunny Florida weather have given Skydive City the reputation as one of the world's premiere drop zones.

Visitors have at their disposal a large viewing deck, high-quality student equipment, rigging service, food concessions, free camping, showers, laundry and a shuttle to major airports. The professional staff will make sure your jump is safe, and photography and video services will capture your experience forever.
